



## SELF-CERTIFICATION To access the Vatican Apostolic Library

### DECLARE UNDER MY RESPONSIBILITY:

- not to be subjected to the mandatory quarantine measure, that is, to not have tested positive to COVID-19 or, in case of a positive test, to have carried out two negative diagnostic swabs for SARS-COV-2;
- if coming from places considered at risk by the Italian government (in particular **Sardinia, Croatia, Greece, Malta, Spain, Romania and Bulgaria**), to have complied with the required obligations in terms of quarantine and diagnostics provided and to be, therefore, in good standing with current indications: <https://www.esteri.it/mae/it/ministero/normativaonline/decreto-iorestoacasa-domande-frequenti/focus-cittadini-italiani-in-rientro-dall-estero-e-cittadini-stranieri-in-italia.html>
- not to have family members or live-in partners positive to COVID-19 and not to have had contact in the last 14 days with other positive COVID-19 people (who has had contact with positive COVID-19 people, if not subjected to a swab, can access only 14 days after being totally asymptomatic);
- not to be subjected to quarantine or fiduciary isolation measures placed by the general practitioner and / or by the designated public health services;
- not to have any of the symptoms attributable to COVID-19 (fever, sore throat, cough, breathing difficulties, loss of smell and taste, intestinal discomfort, diffuse joint and muscle pain or other symptoms);
- to **promptly inform the Library** in case I should subsequently test positive for COVID-19
- to approach the Library equipped with the required individual protective devices (gloves, mask), which I undertake to wear correctly for the duration of my presence in the Study Rooms;
- to respect the access conditions provided by the Library (**limited number and with reduced hours from 8:45 to 13:30, from Monday to Friday**), together with the precautionary provisions (**social distancing, use of individual devices, hand hygiene**) indicated in the information posted throughout the Library.
